
ADULT/COMMUNITY EDUCATION

Depending on budgetary constraints, the Board may establish and maintain a program of adult education and may utilize any of its school facilities for accomplishing the legitimate educational purposes of serving the vocational, avocational, cultural, and aesthetic interests of the community.

Depending on budgetary constraints, the Board may also maintain a program of instruction in English language and in government and laws for the benefit of non-English speakers and candidates for naturalization.

In order to support any program that is provided for adult education and education of non-English speakers or candidates for naturalization, the Board may employ staff, use school facilities as required, and provide necessary custodial services. All professional staff members so employed shall possess valid New Jersey teaching certificates.

In the event that the Board is going to offer such programs, the Superintendent or his/her designee will be directed to seek out and utilize such federal, state, and private sources of revenue as may be appropriate for the financial support of the adult education program.

Adult High School

Depending on budgetary constraints, the Board may establish an adult evening high school for District residents eighteen (18) years of age or over and English language learner (ELL) students who must meet state graduation requirements. All courses for such a program will be adopted by the Board and will include standards of proficiency.
