

DEVELOPING EDUCATIONAL SPECIFICATIONS

To ensure that facilities being planned will facilitate the implementation of the educational program, the Superintendent will provide for the establishment of educational specifications to be considered by the Board and a licensed architect before planning the building or leasing of permanent or temporary school facilities.

The educational specifications will include at least the following:

1. Information concerning the plan of school organization and estimated size and type of pupils enrolled (e.g., age level; mobility; number and kinds of currently enrolled handicapped);
2. The kinds of educational activities;
3. The kinds and amounts of furniture and equipment needed;
4. The relationship among various areas (e.g., band room and library; playing fields and locker rooms, front office and general school control);
5. Special site considerations aesthetics, traffic patterns, cooperative community use, etc.; and
6. Special electrical or plumbing needs; provisions for handicapped or any other similar data.
