

BY-LAW

BOARD ORGANIZATION

The Board of Education is the governing body of the Pennsville Township public schools. It takes action and makes decisions on matters of educational policies as a whole.

The Board conducts its business in an orderly manner in public meetings, with its president as presiding officer. Annually, it elects and appoints personnel who advise and assist it in carrying out its business.

In order to use the time, efforts and expertise of members of the Board efficiently, committees may be authorized to conduct studies, make recommendations to the Board and act in an advisory capacity. Committees are not authorized to act on behalf of the Board.
