

**BY-LAW**

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**REPORTING ACCOMPLISHMENT**

The Board of Education directs the Superintendent to employ all appropriate means to provide for continuous and candid reports of staff accomplishments in the pursuit of District goals and objectives, and to establish reliable indicators of accomplishment. The purpose of these accomplishment reports shall be to provide the Board with information needed for making continual policy and planning decisions.

The Board shall at least annually provide District citizens with an accomplishment report based on this information. As required by law, the accomplishment report shall include the Commissioner of Education's classification of each school within the District and that of the District as a whole.

The annual accomplishment report shall be presented in clear and concise language and be illustrated by meaningful graphics.

Special and/or significant accomplishments of staff, students or the district as a whole shall be announced as they occur at the discretion of the Board.
