Payroll Deduction Program

Dear Colleague,

The Educational Foundation of Pennsville Public School District is an independent, nonprofit corporation whose directors serve without compensation. The Foundation was created to attract private resources exclusively for the benefit of Pennsville Public Schools. Since 2005, the Foundation has attracted more than \$140,000 in donations from Pennsville High School alumni, retired employees, other individuals, and the local business community. These funds have supported a number of projects.

Each year the Foundation's goals are more aggressive. To help teachers receive the opportunity to provide innovative and enriching programs and the supplies necessary for an optimal learning environment, the Foundation instituted a Venture Grant Program for use within individual classrooms.

To help fund the Venture Grant Program, the Foundation has implemented a Staff Payroll Deduction Program. Funds collected from teachers, administrators, and non-instructional personnel are **tax-deductible**, and participation is voluntary. Everyone is invited to participate.

Suggested donations are \$1.00, \$2.00, \$5.00, \$10.00 per pay (Sept.-June), or any amount you deem appropriate. Donations may be deducted from your paycheck each pay period; or, a one-time donation may be returned with the enclosed pledge form.

Our goal this year is to get over 175 employees enrolled into the Payroll Deduction Program. Schools will be recognized for staff participation on a plaque in the following fashion:

50 - 74% participation – Bronze award
75 - 89% participation – Silver award
90% or above – Gold award

The Foundation also encourages you to submit ideas that will help us provide our students with the "edge" they need to compete in school, in the workplace, and in life.

Thank you for your consideration. Your donation will serve as a catalyst for our community-wide campaigns.
