

**PERMISSION TO RIDE BICYCLES TO SCHOOL**  
**RULES FOR BICYCLE RIDING AT**  
**PENNSVILLE SCHOOLS**

No bicycles may be ridden on school property during school hours. All students must walk their bicycles to the racks.

All students, under age 17, must wear a helmet, consistent with New Jersey State law. Students will not be permitted to leave school without a helmet.

The school district is not responsible in case of theft or damage to the bicycle while it is on school property. All bicycles must be locked in the bicycle racks.

Any infraction of the rules can result in suspension of your child's bicycle riding privileges and/or other disciplinary action, as appropriate.

Students through Grade 6 who ride their bicycles are not eligible to participate in the Escort Program.
